

# HOT TUB RULES

(Sorry, but we have to have them)

- DO** Shower before using the Hot Tub (To remove oils, creams etc, which clog the motor)
- DO** Brush any mud/grit from your feet before entering the water
- DO** Replace the lid after use, pulling the skirt down around the edge and fixing with the clips on the 4 locking straps
- DO NOT** Lift the Lid using the skirt, central insulating tabs or locking straps; use only the handles provided and place it carefully in the space beside the Tub
- DO NOT** Use oils, soaps or any detergent in the water
- DO NOT** Use cottage towels for the Hot Tub. Special towels are provided
- DO NOT** Use glassware in the Tub. Plastic glasses are supplied. These are not disposable and should be washed by hand, not in the dishwasher, please
- DO NOT** Eat food or Smoke in the Tub
- DO NOT** Introduce mud, stones, sticks, grit etc into the water
- DO NOT** Jump into the water or play ball games
- DO NOT** Sit, stand or lie on the lid of the Hot Tub at any time
- DO NOT** Press more than one button at once (or it will be cold next time you want to use it). Use only brief pressure on buttons  
(and of course ... **DO NOT** pee in the water !!)

## HEALTH WARNINGS:

Continuously pressing 'Lights' may activate 'Strobe' setting

Hot Tub water may be set around 40 deg C. It contains powerful chemicals to maintain a hygienic environment; **THEREFORE:**

- NO** Children under 12 years may use the Hot Tub
- DO NOT** Leave children unattended in the vicinity of the Tub
- DO NOT** Use the Hot Tub if you are unwell, suffer from heat allergy, are sensitive to chlorine/bromine, or have open wounds
